The House Elections committee was called to order at 9:10 a.m. on Wednesday, March 20th by Chairman Tom Sawyer.

The minutes of the meeting on the 19th were presented for approval or correction. Representative Macy made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Representative Stephens and the motion carried.

The Chair then continued discussion on HB 2454.

Representative Parkinson made a motion to ban direct campaign contributions from business entities and unions, seconded by Representative Baker. Following discussion a vote was taken and the motion passed.

Representative Praeger made a motion to restore the subpoena power to the bill as it was originally written, seconded by Representative Love and the motion carried.

Representative McKechnie made a motion to delete (b) on page 12 of HB 2454, concerning contributions from a candidates' campaign fund being given to another candidate. This was seconded by Representative Macy. Motion failed.

Representative McKechnie made a motion to require complete disclosure of campaign contributions, requiring each report to list any money received, the name of the contributor and the occupation of the contributor, seconded by Representative Stephens. The motion failed.

Representative Parkinson made a motion relating to Section 30, page 24, lines 27-32, concerning representation cases, that would delete these lines, seconded by Representative Macy. Following discussion a vote was taken and the motion failed.

Representative Stephens made a motion to delete "not be construed to" on line 30, page 24 and add "also" and to add "over \$1,000" to line 28 following "representation case". This was seconded by Representative Shallenburger and the motion carried.

Representative Sawyer made a motion to add "unless it is put out for competitive bid" to line 3, page 25, concerning performing services for a state agency. This was seconded by Representative Love and the motion passes.

Chairman Sawyer adjourned the Elections committee at 10:00 a.m. The next meeting of the House Elections Committee will be Thursday, March 21st, Room 521-S at 9:00 a.m.
