MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS

Chair counted and announced that a quorum was present. She shared with the Committee concerns that SB 385, as passed by the Federal and State Affairs Committee, had serious problems and was not going to be considered on the Floor. She shared with the Committee her concerns that unless Section G, subsection g. was passed, and Lotto America incorporated, which was expected in the next few months, Kansas would lose the ability to contract with Lotto America.

The Chair suggested that the Committee reconsider action on SB 385 and pull it back into the Committee. She said if that motion was successful, she would recommend that the bill be stripped to include only the language contained in Section G, subsection g, so that Kansas could continue the relationship with Lotto America.

Representative Empson moved to reconsider action on SB 385. Representative Edlund made a second to the motion, which passed on a voice vote.

Representative Sprague moved to delete all of SB 385, with the exception of the language in Section 3, Subsection (3). Representative Jones made a second to the motion, which passed on a voice vote.

Mary Torrence, the Revisor, suggested that a substitute bill was more appropriate than a drastically amended bill.

Representative Lawrence moved the Committee report Substitute SB 385 favorable for passage. Representative Hamilton made a second to the motion, which passed on a voice vote.

Having no further business, Chair Sebelius adjourned the meeting.
