Chairman Blumenthal called the meeting to order when quorum was present.

HB 2514 - AN ACT concerning certain animals; relating to licensure and regulation of certain persons dealing in animals; creating the Kansas animal dealers commission.

Rep. Brown reported that there is a need to make several significant changes before passage is possible from this committee; primarily dealing with removal from the Livestock Commissioner's jurisdiction to a separate commission. Chair indicated he would request Majority Leader to refer it to an exempt committee and then re-refer back to this committee.

HB 2277 - AN ACT relating to public officers and employees; requiring certain officers and employees to receive a tax clearance concerning the payment of state income taxes as a condition precedent to assuming the duties of such public office or employment.

Rep. Ramirez moved to approve HB 2277 favorable, motion seconded by Rep. Lawrence, discussion followed. Motion to table bill made by Rep. Lahti, seconded by Rep. Bowden, division called, motion passed to table HB 2277.
