SB 456 - AN ACT changing the name of the commission on civil rights to the Kansas human rights commission.

Senator Anderson spoke in support of SB 456. In urging the committee to report this bill favorably, Senator Anderson advised that the current name gives the perception that the commission only serves minorities. Since the Commission has become so broad, the name is no longer appropriate.

Motion to pass SB 456 favorably was made by Rep. McClure, seconded by Rep. Brown, brief discussion followed, motion carried.

Motion to approve minutes for April 25th and April 27th was made by Rep. Weimer, seconded by Rep. Bishop, motion carried.
