He told the committee that the Senate had passed Senate Bill No. 425 and is now in our committee. This bill has been amended into House Bill No. 2457.

The chairman explained some of the changes in House Bill No. 2457. These were the amendments that the Senate made at Secretary Michael Johnston's request.

Representative Al Lane suggested we pass Senate Bill No. 425 in case House Bill No. 2457 did not pass.

Representative Denise Everhart made the motion to pass House Bill No. 2457. Representative George Gomez seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative Lane made a motion to pass Senate Bill 425. Representative Jack Sluiter seconded. Motion carried.
