MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Vice-Chairman Gomez called for discussion on HB 2026.

HB 2026 - Act concerning rural water districts; relating to the dissolution thereof.

Vice-Chairman called on staff to state the changes needed. Ms Kiernan stated staff would strike out the word "probably" on line 22.

Representative Harder moved to amend HB 2026 by striking "probably" on line 22, seconded by Representative Holmes. The motion carried.
No discussion.

Representative Mollenkamp moved to pass HB 2026 as amended, seconded by Representative Wempe. Motion carried.

BILL REQUESTS

Suzie Parmer, Register of Deeds from Leavenworth Co., representing the Kansas Register of Deeds Association appeared before the committee to request a bill relating to filing fee increases.

A motion was made by Representative Holmes to request the bill, seconded by Representative Stephens. The motion carried.

Vice-Chairman stated Representative Sebelius requested a bill relating to KDFA; financing municipal-lease purchase equipment.

A motion was made by Representative Harder and seconded by Representative Mollenkamp to introduce the above bill. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman informed the committee that this was County Government Day and asked guests for self-introductions if they were from local government.

Invitations to attend a dinner sponsored by The Kansas Association of Counties and the League of Kansas Municipalities on February 13, 1991 was distributed to committee members and staff. The Vice-Chairman asked the committee members to RSVP to the committee secretary.

A motion was made by Representative Holmes to approve the minutes of January 30, 1991, seconded by Representative Brown. The motion carried.
