The meeting was called to order at 7:39 a.m.

Chairman Rezac reminded the Committee that at the last meeting a motion had been made to combine HB 2203 and HB 2197 into a Committee bill. This bill has been introduced and the number is HB 2404, which will be discussed today.

The Chairman also told the Committee that all bills which are passed by Pensions do have to go through Appropriations whether there is any fiscal note or not. He then asked for discussion on HB 2404.

Representative Cornfield moved that we pass HB 2404, seconded by Representative Flottman, motion carried.

The Chairman told the Committee that there would be a revised agenda out to have a meeting next Wednesday morning.

Due to several Committee members being late, it was brought up that action on this bill just passed needed to be reconsidered for the benefit of their voting.

Representative Wisdom made a motion to reconsider action on the bill, seconded by Representative Flottman, motion carried.

The Chairman told the Committee members that Representative Cornfield had made a motion to pass HB 2404 and it was seconded by Representative Flottman - motion carried again.
