SB 281 - Increasing fees for 72 hour permits.

SB 282 - Increasing the fee for motor-vehicle fuel tax refund permits.

Final action on SB 345.

SB 345 - Drivers Licenses, Commercial Driver's License Act.

Representative McClure moved to pass SB 345 and put on consent calendar. Representative Gross seconded. Motion carried.

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**SENATE BILL 281**

Senate Bill 281 was requested by the Department of Revenue to amend K.S.A. 8-143i to increase the fee for "Beyond Local" 72 hour permits from \$20.00 to \$26.00. This permit allows trucks registered as "local" to go beyond the local radius authorized by that local registration.

These permits are sold by County Treasurers and approximately 200 are sold each year. The receipts to the State Highway Fund would increase approximately \$1,200 per year. The "Beyond Local" is the only 72 hour permit that was not increased to \$26.00 two years ago when all other 72 hour permits were increased accordingly.

**SENATE BILL 282**

Senate Bill 282 was requested by the Department and amends K.S.A. 79-3454. This bill increase the fee for obtaining a motor-fuel tax refund permit fee from \$1.00 every three years to \$6.00 every three years. The increase allows the Department to recover mailing and processing costs of the refund application permit.

We estimate that receipts to the State General Fund will increase by \$33,435.
