Further discussion on S.B. 267 - Motor vehicle dealers establishment
or relocation of new vehicle dealers.

Mike Grogan said his Coalition had been formed because many dealers wanted a different approach from the Kansas Motor Car Dealers Association. His Coalition does not support this legislation. They believe in the free enterprise system.

There was some discussion that the major manufacturers have dispute resolutions in place. The only ones involved in this would be foreign manufacturers who do not have these mechanisms in place. This bill would be a substitute for those not having dispute resolutions.

Mr. Grogan said it would probably run into legal problems.
