Senator Gaines moved, Senator Winter seconded that the following bill drafts be introduced:

1 RS 0488 - An act concerning crimes and punishment; providing for a presumptive sentencing guidelines system

1 RS 0185 - An act concerning the Kansas Sentencing Commission; relating to the members and duties thereof

1 RS 1351 - An act concerning the technical professions; relating to the Board of Technical Professions; concerning licensing of persons to practice the technical professions; relating to the validity of certain building permits requiring technical submissions; authorizing the board to impose civil fines and costs for certain violations

The motion carried.

Senator Allen moved, Senator Doyen seconded, the introduction of bill draft 1 RS 1417 - an act concerning taxation; relating to certain airport authorities; exemption from taxation. The motion carried.
