Chairman Blumenthal called meeting to order when quorum was present.

Hearing on SB 470 - An act concerning the appointment of person to boards and commissions; concerning the duties of certain state officers.

Julian Efird clarified for the committee the purpose of SB 470. He advised that whenever there is a new administration, there is a lack of central data base indicating when terms expire and what appointments are available. A current data base would assist both the Governor's positions and others who have appointing authority.

Chair offered an amendment which specifically states that when the Governor makes a cabinet position appointment during the legislative session, and an acting secretary is appointed, the appointment must be subject to Senate confirmation.

Motion by Representative Brown to amend SB 470, motion seconded by Representative Hackler, motion carried.

On bill as a whole, motion by Representative Weimer to approve SB 470 favorable as amended, motion seconded by Representative Ramirez, motion carried.
