Mrs. Emalene Correll of the Research Department presented a staff review of HB 2511 which was described as a joint underwriting plan rather than a risk pool. Mrs. Correll led the committee through the bill section by section. This bill would provide insurance for primary care only and would have at least a \$5,000 deductible. Pre-existing conditions would not disallow those eligible for the insurance. Mental illness would not be covered in this bill. Subsidization by the state would be required for this insurance.

Representative Helgerson moved for the approval of the minutes of January 23, 1992. Representative Welshimer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Chairman Turnquist welcomed the new committee member, Representative Sebelius. Representative Pauls has been transferred to another committee.
