Chairman Solbach called the meeting to order for consideration of bills in Committee.

Art Solis addressed his request for a conflict resolution bill which he made yesterday. Jill Wolters said that to speed up the conflict resolution, his request could be amended into SB 233 by striking all of SB 233 and making it a substitute bill. Representative Smith moved that SB 233 be amended as suggested. Rep. Douville seconded the motion. Discussion followed. Motion carried. Rep. Gregory requested to be recorded as voting no.

Rep. Smith moved to recommend Substitute SB 233 favorably for passage. Rep. Douville seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative O'Neal requested a bill be introduced on recommendation of the Bulter County Commissioners to have the sheriff collect certain expenses. Discussion followed. Rep. O'Neal moved to introduce such bill. Rep. Smith seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Rep. Smith moved to reconsider action on Arthur Solis' s request from yesterday to introduce a conflict resolution bill. Rep. Douville seconded the motion. Motion carried.

On the motion to introduce the conflict resolution bill, the motion failed.
