The meeting was called to order at 9:06 a.m., by the chairman, Rep. Anthony Hensley.

Chairman Hensley explained that the purpose of the meeting was to hear a staff briefing on House Bill No. 3023, introduced by Rep. Michael R. O'Neal and others. He then introduced Jim Wilson, committee revisor.

Mr. Wilson stated that House Bill No. 3023 proposes thirty-five (35) specific changes in the Kansas Workers' Compensation act. The chairman informed the committee that members did not have the corrected copy of the bill which did not list Rep. Allan White as a co-sponsor. He said the members would receive a corrected copy of the bill at the meeting tomorrow.

Mr. Wilson went through the bill section by section to explain the proposed changes, and answered questions from committee members.

The chairman announced that the public hearings on House Bill No. 3023 would begin at the committee's meeting tomorrow, Wednesday, February 19, 1992.
