Senator Yost moved to amend SB-713, page 1, line 26, deleting April 1, 1992 and inserting March 15, 1992. Senator Lee seconded the motion and the motion carried.

A brief discussion followed to determine this bill concerned only the 1992 reapportionment.

Senator Lee moved to pass SB-713 out favorable as amended. Senator Yost seconded the motion and the motion carried.

There was discussion concerning the quickest manner in which to advance this bill.
