The meeting was called to order shortly after 1:30 p.m.

SB-725 - Concerning absentee voting.

Senate Bill 725 was a clean-up bill concerning statute K.S.A. 25-1122. During discussion concern was expressed by Joe de la Torre, Office of the Secretary of State, that SB-725 could cause difficulties with the Presidential Primary. Since the bill entailed "cleanup" legislation and action could be postponed, Senator Rock, with a second by Senator Martin, moved to table SB-725. The motion carried.

SB-726 - concerning statement of expenditures of candidates for election to office in certain political subdivisions of the state.

A brief discussion on SB-726 was held.

Senator Martin made a motion to report SB-725 favorable for passage. Senator Rock seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The minutes of February 24, 25 and 26 were presented for approval.

Senator Rock, with a second from Senator Martin moved approval of the minutes. The motion carried.
