MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Senator Wint Winter Jr. at 7:10 p.m. on April 10, 1992 at the third floor rail of the Capitol.

Chairman Winter called the meeting to order at the brass rail of the third floor.

HB 2690 - establishment of Joint Committee on Children and Families

Senator Morris, having voted on the prevailing side, moved to reconsider the Committee's actions in recommending HB 2690 favorable for passage. Senator Bond, having voted on the prevailing side, seconded the motion. The motion to reconsider carried.

Senator Bond moved to amend HB 2690 by including an amended version of HB 3143 as approved by the Committee during the meeting on April 8, 12:40 p.m.. Senator Morris seconded the motion. The motion to amend carried.

HB 3143 - Sub for HB 3143: task force on criminal justice information, recommendations for a uniform database of offender information.

Senator Bond moved to further amend HB 2690 to establish the Kansas Criminal Justice Coordinating Council/Sentencing Commission as suggested by Secretary of Corrections Stotts, making sure to include CINC and juvenile offenders, assigning the task of drafting legislation for introduction by the Legislature, and to include one person from DISC for advising. Senator Morris seconded the motion. The motion to amend carried.

Senator Morris moved to recommend HB 2690 favorable as amended. Senator Bond seconded the motion. The motion carried.
