Requests for introduction of bills

Ernie Mosher, Research Counsel, League of Kansas Municipalities presented requests for introduction of three bills. The first one is a consolidation of services act. The second is an interlocal services contract act and the third is a privatization of public services.

Senator Webb moved and Senator Frahm seconded the motion these bills be introduced. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on bills previously heard.

SB 93 concerning taxing subdivisions; relating to the budgets thereof.

Senator Petty moved the bill be reported adversely. Senator Frahm seconded the motion. Motion carried.

SB 116 concerning authorizing the board of county commissioners of Miami county to establish an airport authority.

Senator Frahm moved the bill be reported adversely. Senator Ehrlich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

SB 126 concerning Wyandotte county; relating to the powers and duties of the board of county commissioners.

Senator Ehrlich moved this bill be reported adversely. Senator Lee seconded the motion. Motion carried.

SB 186 relating to county roads and bridges. The Chairperson announced this bill will be discussed on Tuesday, February 4, 1992.

SB 260 concerning the payment for construction goods and services. The committee requested the bill be held in committee.

SB 264 relating to the compensation of county treasurers. Senator Frahm moved this bill be reported adversely. Senator Gaines seconded the motion. Motion carried.

SB 348 concerning Cherokee county; relating to the election of county commissioners.

Senator Webb moved the bill be reported adversely. Senator Gaines seconded the motion. Motion carried.
