Action on Sub. H.B. 3005 - Sub. for HB 3005 by Committee on Energy and Natural Resources  
Prohibiting inclusion of costs of certain unregulated utility  
businesses in rates.

The original bill would have established a state policy that no public utility would be permitted to engage in any activity which is in competition with private enterprise, unless the public utility demonstrated that an overriding or compelling public interest was served by engaging in that activity. This bill would require a separate accounting system for all nonregulated private enterprises engaged in by those utilities.

A motion was made by Sen. Rock to recommend Sub. H.B. 3005 favorably for passage.  
Motion was seconded by Sen. Martin. Motion carried.
