

**MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS.**

The meeting was called to order by Senator August "Gus" Bogina, Chairperson, at 11:07 a.m. on January 16, 1992 in Room 123-S of the Capitol.

Chairman Bogina welcomed Senator Moran as a new member of the Committee, replacing Senator Allen. He introduced staff assigned to the Committee, Kathy Porter and Leah Robinson, Kansas Research Department; Norman Furse, Revisors' Office, Judy Bromich, Administrative Assistant; Ronda Miller, Committee Secretary.

The Chairman requested that members reserve a time period from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 21, 1992 for a committee meeting.

Senator Feleciano moved, Senator Doyen seconded, the introduction of bill draft RS 1955, an act making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June, 30, 1992 for the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Rock and seconded by Senator Doyen to introduce all 1993 appropriation bills submitted by the Governor. The motion carried by a voice vote.

It was moved by Senator Rock, seconded by Senator Kerr, that bill draft RS 1853, an act relating to certain fees and receipts collected by legislative agencies, be introduced. The motion carried on a voice vote.
