A motion was made by Representative Lowther, seconded by Representative Neufeld, to introduce a bill regarding KPERs, relating to prior service.

A motion was made by Representative Lowther, seconded by Representative Gatlin, to introduce a bill regarding KPERs, relating to employer contributions. The motion carried.
