MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS.

The Chairperson stated that final action would be taken on **HB 2102** and **HCR 5008** and Representative Mays would be asking for a bill introduction.

Representative Mays requested that an act concerning alcoholic liquor; relating to consumption in certain places; amending K.S.A. 41-719 and repealing the existing section. Under Section 1, paragraph (g) add (c) "the Mulvane art center and the Bradbury Thompson alumni center on the campus of Washburn university; and other".

Representative Adkins moved and Representative Packer seconded that requested bill amending K.S.A. 41-719 be introduced as a committee bill. The motion carried.

The Chairperson stated when the committee adjourned January 26, there was a motion to move **HB 2102** out of committee adversely and would like to vote on that motion.

After a final vote, **HB 2102** was reported out of committee adversely.

The Chairperson asked the committee what there wishes were on **HCR 5008**.

Representative Packer moved and Representative Donovan seconded to move **HCR 5008** out of committee favorably. The motion was in doubt and the Chairperson asked for a show of hands -- 11 yeas and 6 nays. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 1:40 p.m. The next meeting will be February 2, 1995.
