Chair apprised the committee of the schedule of issues to be covered for this week.

Chair opened for consideration of:

**HB 2116 - Property tax appraisal cycle timing.**

Moved by Mays, seconded by Kirk, amend HB 2116 by inserting on line 29 the words "cities or" before 'county' and on line 30 the words "city or" before 'county'. Motion carried.

Moved by Larkin, seconded by Wempe, HB 2116 be reported adversely.

Moved by Edmonds, seconded by Welshimer, HB 2116 be tabled. Motion carried with 2 no votes.

Rep. Pettey asked for consideration of introduction of two committee bills.

Moved by Pettey, seconded by Kirk, introduction of a bill that would authorize tax credits for hiring of persons receiving welfare assistance. Motion carried.

Moved by Pettey, seconded by Kirk, introduction of a bill to authorize dedicating a percentage of sales tax collected from coupon sales to juvenile crime issues. Motion carried with 1 no vote.
