Vice-Chairman Don Myers called the meeting to order at 11:35 a.m. at the rail.

The purpose of the meeting was the introduction of two bills. The Department of Transportation requested introduction of a bill which would require the wearing of a helmet when riding a motorcycle or a motorized bicycle. Representative Shore made a motion to introduce this legislation, seconded by Representative Crabb and the motion carried.

Representative Hochhauser requested introduction of a bill which would require any person under the age of 14 years to be required to wear a protective bicycle helmet when either operating or a passenger on a bicycle. Representative Edmonds made a motion to introduce this bill, seconded by Representative Humerickhouse and the motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Myers adjourned the meeting at 11:40 a.m.
