Senator Hardenburger requested approval of the minutes from March 14, 1995 meeting.

Senator Salle made a motion to approve the minutes and was seconded by Senator Clark. The motion carried.

HB 2123--relates to elections; concerning political advertising

Arden Ensley briefly discussed the changes in **HB 2123**. He stated the purpose of the law is to allow the public to know who publishes or broadcasts election material. Discussion followed concerning the placing of the name of the treasurer of the campaign appearing on printed material.

Senator Bond made a motion for **HB 2123** to amend the definition of "engage" or "engaging" to include the paying of costs incurred by a person to cover printed material publications and to pay for broadcasting for election purpose. The motion was seconded by Senator Clark. The motion carried.
