The Chair called for introduction of four bills requested by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment regarding abuse and neglect in adult care homes, prenatal tests for Hepatitis B, release of death information and disclosure of vital record information. The Chair also requested introduction of a bill that would allow the Citizen Review Board to review cases of juvenile offenders when reviewing children in need of care. Senator Walker made a motion the Committee recommend introduction of the proposed legislation, seconded by Senator Jones. The motion carried.
