It was moved by Senator Rock and seconded by Senator Karr that the minutes of April 27, 1995 be approved as presented. The motion carried on a voice vote.

HB 2077 **KPERS, REQUIRING INDEPENDENT ACTUARIAL AUDIT AND EVALUATION OF KPERS ACTUARY'S DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

(Please see the minutes of March 24 and 30 and the subcommittee report on HB 2555) -- all provisions for the independent actuarial audit had been deleted from HB 2077 and provisions for the COLA for retired members had been reinserted by earlier Committee action.)

The Chairman stated that he would entertain a motion to amend HB 2077. It was moved by Senator Kerr and seconded by Senator Morris that HB 2077 be amended by striking all the provisions and reinserting new provisions which would reinstate the Lottery and that HB 2077 as amended be sent to the Committee of the Whole without recommendation. Members discussed the sunset date of 2002 and the types of lottery games which would be authorized. It was noted that any new on-line games would require the approval of the Governor. The motion carried on a roll call vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:40 P.M.
