MINUTES OF THE SELECT COMMITTEE ON JUVENILE CRIME.

David Adkins introduced Lisa Moots to the committee. Lisa gave an overview of the activities of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council . She reported on the status of the Council's task force. This was to include recommendations regarding the juvenile justice system, including issues of jurisdiction, placement, intake and assessment processes, dispositional alternatives, financing strategies, availability of mental health services and work processes and case loads of social workers and court services officers, the implications of a youth authority and any other issues affecting children in need of care as defined in K.S.A. 38-1501 et seq. and juvenile offenders as defined in K.S.A. 38-1601 et seq. and amendments thereto. It is anticipated their report will be finished by March 1.

She specifically updated the committee on research involving juvenile crime statistics and juvenile offender profiles. She outlined classifications of juvenile offenders and discussed the concept of a continuum of placement options for juvenile offenders.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m. The next meeting is scheduled for January 25, 1995.
