MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Robin Jennison at 1:30 p.m. on March 20, 1996 in Room 514-S of the Capitol.

Chairman Jennison called the meeting to order by recognizing Representative Lowther to give a report and answer questions on the scheduling of audits on KGOAL and KPERS.

A motion was made by Representative Neufeld, seconded by Representative Minor, to strike pages one and two (the entire bill) from SB 387. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Carmody, seconded by Representative Mollenkamp, to recommend SB 387 favorably for passage, as amended. The motion carried.

Discussion then moved to **SB 3047**. Staff distributed a substitute bill for **SB 3047** which served as the subcommittee report.

A motion was made by Representative Neufeld, seconded by Representative Minor, to adopt the subcommittee report on **HB 3047**, which is the substitute bill. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Hochhauser, seconded by Representative Neufeld, to amend **HB 3047** by striking the first sentence of new section 3 and move new section 19 into new section 3. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Dean, seconded by Representative Helgherson, to amend **HB 3047** by adding language that would eliminate the 300% cap. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Helgherson, seconded by Representative Dean, to amend **HB 3047** by adding language to require that the Governor's budget shall have a minimum floor level and that regular cost of living increases be given to the Department on Aging. The motion failed. Representative Helgherson and Representative Dean voted yes.

Vice Chairman Carmody presided over the meeting due to Chairman Jennison excusing himself from the meeting.

A motion was made by Representative Helgherson, seconded by Representative Hochhauser, to strike any necessary language in **HB 3047** to keep the program concerning area directors within the SRS system the same as it is now. The motion failed.

A motion was made by Representative Dean, seconded by Representative Helgherson, to amend **HB 3047** by stating that any area agencies requesting and receiving money from the grant fund will submit a report on how that money was spent. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Nichols, seconded by Representative Helgherson, to amend new section 20 to say the House Appropriations chairman will appoint 6 members to the committee, 4 from the majority

party and 2 from the minority party.

After discussion, Representative Nichols and Representative Helgerson withdrew the motion.

A motion was made by Representative Jennison, seconded by Representative Nichols to amend new section 20 of HB 3047 to say the House Appropriations chairman will appoint 5 members to the committee, 3 from the majority party and 2 from the minority party. The motion carried.

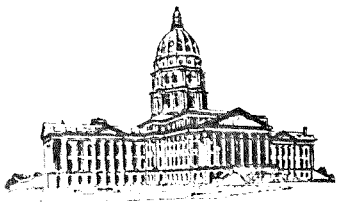
A motion was made by Representative Neufeld, seconded by Representative Nichols to make the technical corrections in section 20 of HB 3047 to reflect the proper name of the House Public Health and Welfare committee. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Neufeld, seconded by Representative Hochhauser, to make technical corrections in section c by striking "as authorized by the Legislative Coordinating Council." The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Neufeld, seconded by Representative Jennison, to recommend HB 3047 favorably for passage. The motion carried.
