Committee action on:

**HB 2864 - Concerning Kansas Industries for the Blind**

Rep. Becker made a motion to recommend HB 2864 favorably for passage. It was seconded by Rep. Ruff. Rep. Grant made a substitute motion to amend the bill as follows: "Any product or service in the Kansas Use Catalog before the effective date of this act shall receive first priority for contracts." It was seconded by Rep. Beggs. The motion carried. A motion was made by Rep. Standifer to recommend the passage of the bill favorably as amended. It was seconded Rep. Presta. The motion carried.

Committee action on:

**HB 2814 - Repeal of brokerage relationships in real estate transactions act.**

Rep. Merritt made a motion to advance the bill to the House without a hearing and without a recommendation. It was seconded by Rep. Grant. The motion failed.
