HB 2995 - tax credit for certain alternative-fueled motor vehicle property

The Chair opened **HB 2995** for discussion and final action.

Representative Dillon made a motion to pass **HB 2995** favorably, seconded by Representative Shore and the motion carried

SB 201 - concerning authorized emergency vehicles; relating to the designation thereof

Representative Shore made a motion to take **SB 201** off the table, seconded by Representative Dillon and the motion carried.

Representative Shore made a motion to amend **SB 201** to include portions of **HB 2128**, page 1 (b) beginning on line 36 with "shall be equipped with fixed mounted rotating or oscillating lights" and continue through ©, seconded by Representative Myers and the motion carried. Representatives McKinney and Representative Correll requested their "no" vote be recorded.

On recommendation of staff, Representative Shore made a motion to leave Sections 1 and 2 of **HB 2128** in the bill as well as making any technical corrections necessary in respect to dates. This was seconded by Representative Pottorff and the motion carried.

Representative Shore made a motion to pass **SB 201** favorably, as amended, seconded by Representative Myers and the motion carried. Representative Correll requested his "no" vote be recorded.

HB 3011 - requiring certificates of title for vessels

Following discussion by the committee no action was taken on **HB 3011**.
