MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION.

**SB 662 - certificate of title fees, disposition**

The Chair opened **SB 662** for discussion and final action.

Representative Powell, having voted on the prevailing side, made a motion to reconsider the amendments which were passed on 3/26/96. This was seconded by Representative Donovan. The motion carried.

Representative Powell made a motion to withdraw the substitute motion, seconded by Representative Correll and the motion carried.

Representative Shore made a motion to withdraw the original motion, seconded by Representative Pauls and the motion carried.

Representative Shore made a conceptual motion that through June 30, 1997, the title fee would remain at \$7.00 and of each title fee collected, \$2.00 would be credited to the Kansas highway patrol motor vehicle fund and \$1.50 be deposited with the state treasurer and credited to the VIPS hardware fee fund. The \$2.00 credited to the highway patrol motor vehicle fund may also be used to purchase and secure fixed mounted rotating or oscillating lights on the patrol cars. After one year the amount of the title fee would be reduced from \$7.00 to \$4.50, with \$1.00 of this amount to be credited to the VIPS hardware fee fund. The motion also would amend **HB 3076** into this bill which allows the Secretary of Revenue to charge and collect fees for copies of public records. This money would be credited to the electronic data base fee fund. This motion was seconded by Representative Dillon. The motion carried.

Representative Shore made a motion to pass **SB 662** as amended, seconded by Representative Dillon and the motion carried.

The Chair adjourned the meeting at 11:15 a.m.
