The meeting of the Senate Governmental Organization Committee was called to order by Senator Ramirez at 1:45 p.m. He called for action on the Minutes of January 16, January 17 and January 18, 1996. Senator Feleciano moved the minutes of January 16, January 17 and January 18, 1996 be approved. Senator Steffes gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The agenda for the meeting was consideration of SB 163--regulation of elevators, escalators and similar equipment and HB 2129--unlawful use of state postage.

The Chairman called for a motion to take the bills from the table. Senator Papay moved to take SB 163 from the table. Senator Reynolds gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.
Senator Feleciano was recorded as voting no.

Senator Feleciano moved to take HB 2129 from the table. Senator Reynolds gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

Julian Efird, Legislative Research Department, briefed the committee on **HB 2129**, and gave background information on the bill.

The committee discussed what it thought the intent of the bill was and what it was attempting to accomplish. After several comments, it was decided not to take action on the bill until more information could be obtained.
