Representative McKinney requested a bill which would designate a portion of United States Highway 54 from the east city limits of Kingman to the west city limits of Greensburg as the Cannonball Stageline Highway. He explained that signage for this section would not be at the expense of the state as private funds were being raised. No signs will be placed until the money for this project is received.

A motion was made by Senator Jones to introduce this legislation. This was seconded by Senator Harrington and the motion carried.

The Staff briefed the Committee on the carry over bills and explained their intent. There was some discussion and at the suggestion of the Chairman a motion was made by Senator Rock to kill SB 148 concerning license plates for recipients of the purple heart or equivalent medal and SB 199 which concerned lighting requirements for rear license plates. A seconded was made by Senator Papay. Motion carried.
