**HB 2707 - CONCERNING BUILDING ENERGY EFFICIENCY STANDARDS;**

David Schlosser discussed the energy code relating to savings and affordability of houses. He pointed out that if this legislation passes, builders will not have to apply to the building codes and homebuilders will be installing other types of energy saving materials and will not be considering the entire system of the house. If this bill is not passed nothing will change.

There were some questions and a brief discussion but no action was taken.

A motion was made by Senator Papay to approve the minutes of the March 26th meeting. A second was made by Senator Jones. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 by the Chairman.

**NOTE:** Due to an oversight, **HB 2707** was not re-referred from Senate Ways and Means to the Senate Transportation and Utilities Committee. Therefore the action taken in the meeting of March 26, 1996 to pass **HB 2707** favorably out of Committee was not valid.
