

MINUTES OF THE CALENDAR AND PRINTING COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Robin Jennison at 2:09 p.m. on February 17, 1996 in Room 380-W of the Capitol.

The meeting was called for the purpose of discussion and possible action on HB 2110 - changing the term of certain committees chairpersons.

The committee heard from guest speaker: Janet Jones.

Janet Jones, Chief Clerk of the House for eight years, stated it would be simpler to have all committees change chairpersons in January rather than some in July.

Committee Staff member, Norman Furse suggested the State Building Construction Committee, Economic Development Committee, Computers and Telecommunications Committee and the Pensions, Investments, and Benefits Committee be changed to January. Mr. Furse also suggested changing the statutory reference of the Senate Committee on Transportation and Utilities and the House Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Senate Committee on Transportation and Tourism and the House Committee on Environment.

After discussion was held, motion was made by Representative Shallenburger to make the appropriate changes on HB 2110. Motion was seconded by Representative Alldritt and was passed unanimously. Motion was then made by Representative Shallenburger to move HB 2110 to the House for debate. Motion was seconded by Representative Mays and passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting adjourned at 2:13 p.m.
