HB 2071 - Agent Licensing and CE

Chairman Bradley opened the hearing and recognized Tom Wilder, Kansas Insurance Department, who explained the bill concerns cleanup of licensing laws, assessing penalties, lapsing and reinstatement of license with retesting, notifying Dept. within 30 days of hiring new agent in the agency, emphasizing that the fee is not refundable.

Because of many questions by various representatives, Mr. Wilder promised to get the answers from the Agents and Brokers Division and get back to the committee as soon as possible.

Chairman Bradley declined to work the bill until further information on the hearing was obtained and declared the meeting adjourned.
