Continued hearing on **HB 2081: File and Use Substitute Bill.**

In the absence of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Representative Dennis Wilson opened the meeting and continued the hearing on **HB 2081**. **Representative Tomlinson moved that Substitute HB 2081 be passed.
