SB 93: Conversion of domestic mutual insurer to domestic stock insurer. Chairman Tom Bradley opened the meeting and a motion was made by Representative Wilson that the bill as

amended be passed out favorably. It was seconded by Representative Kirk and passed.

SB 204: Health insurance reform act.

A motion by Representative Johnson and seconded by Representative Stone that the bill be amended with balloon was passed. A substitute motion by Representative Kirk that the bill be passed our favorably as it came from the Senate was seconded by Representative Flora but failed.
