**SB 93: Conversion of domestic mutual insurer to domestic stock insurer.**

Chairman Tom Bradley opened the meeting and a motion was made by Representative Wilson that the bill as amended be passed out favorably. It was seconded by Representative Kirk and passed.

**SB 204: Health insurance reform act.**

A motion by Representative Johnson and seconded by Representative Stone that the bill be amended with balloon was passed. A substitute motion by Representative Kirk that the bill be passed out favorably as it came from the Senate was seconded by Representative Flora but failed.

Representative Garner made a motion to amend SB 204 to include HB 2417. It was seconded by Representative Burroughs and the motion passed.

Representative Empson made a motion to include technical amendments into the bill, seconded by Representative Compton and the motion passed.

A motion was made by Representative Wilson and seconded by Representative Empson that the bill as amended be passed out favorably. The motion passed.

**SCR 1601: Establishing task force to study insurance industry.**

A motion made by Representative Campbell, seconded by Representative Wilson to untable SCR 1601 was passed. A motion by Representative Kirk, seconded by Representative Krehbiel to change the date of July 1, 1997 to July 1, 1998. Bill was passed out favorably.

**HB 2297: Mandating insurance coverage for reconstructive surgery after breast surgery.**

Representative Krehbiel made a motion to pass the bill out favorably. Representative Burroughs seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Representative Campbell introduced his daughter to the committee.
