MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY & NATURAL RESOURCES.

1. To change the buddy permit for bow hunters from three to four people.

2. To lower the bow hunter age to twelve years old, with strict adult supervision, including bow hunting safety training classes.

Senator Morris, with a second from Senator Huelskamp moved to introduce the bill. The motion carried.
