MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS.

The meeting was called to order by Senator Lana Oleen at 2:20 p.m. on April 9, 1997, at the Rail on the third floor of the Capitol outside the Senate Chamber.

The committee met to consider an amendment to **HB 2509**, an act relating to the Board of Technical Professions.

Senator Biggs moved to withdraw his motion to favorably report **HB 2509** to the full Senate, a motion made at a regularly scheduled committee meeting earlier in the day. Senator Harrington withdrew her second on the motion. The motion carried.

Discussion followed concerning the name change provision of the bill.

Senator Vidricksen moved to delete the name change provision and to retain the name as the Board of Technical Professions; Senator Herrington seconded the motion, and the motion passed without dissent.
