HB 2042 - Fiduciary security transfers, tax obligations

Following discussion of **HB 2042** Senator Pugh made a motion that the bill be passed and placed on the consent calendar, Senator Oleen seconded. After discussion Senator Pugh withdrew that portion of the motion "and be placed on the consent calendar", and with Senator Oleen's second, motion carried.

HB 2055 - Nonprobate transfers of real estate

Following discussion regarding amending **HB 2055** to include the Association of Funeral Directors provisions which would change the language in the bill to insure priority payment for funeral expenses, Senator Oleen moved to pass the bill as amended, Senator Goodwin seconded. Motion carried.

HB 2056 - Nonprobate transfers of real estate

Following discussion Senator Donovan moved to pass **HB 2056** out favorably, Senator Harrington seconded. Motion carried.

HB 2422 - Transfer of real property on death of owner; relating to an heir who files a notification of interest in title.

It was the consensus of the committee following extended discussion on **HB 2422** to take no action at this time.

Committee discussed several Senate Bills which haven't been worked in the House yet, one of which, **SB 375, Abuse, neglect and exploitation of certain persons**, was then assigned by the Chair to a subcommittee consisting of Senators Pugh, Petty and Goodwin.

Meeting adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
