Substitute SB 402 - Post-secondary education savings programs, feasibility study

Representative Shore made a motion to report **Substitute SB 402** favorably for passage. Representative Empson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

SB 298 - State board of education prohibited from issuing certificate to certain persons

Representative Morrison made a motion to report **SB 298** favorably for passage. Representative Stone seconded the motion.

Representative Flaharty made a motion to strike on page 2, line 9 "committed" and replace with "been convicted of committing". Add on line 10 "who has entered into a criminal diversion agreement after having been charged with an offense or act described in subsection (b)." Representative Toelkes seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Wempe made a motion to remove the due process hearing, dealing with employment contracts, at the local level if a finding has been determined during the due process hearing at the state level that the teachers certificate has been revoked or not renewed for acts covered by the bill. Representative Ballou seconded the motion. The motion carried on a vote of 7-6.

Representative Stone made a motion to add on page 2, line 15, "if a person has entered into a criminal diversion agreement and that person has satisfied the terms and conditions of the agreement". Representative Horst seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Aurand made a motion to report **SB 298** favorably for passage, as amended. Representative Morrison seconded the motion. The motion carried.
