MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Alicia Salisbury at 8:00 a.m. on January 27, 1997 in Room 123-S of the Capitol.

Staff distributed an article from the Lawrence Journal-World, regarding the Supreme Court's recent agreement to review whether the federal government or the states should play the dominate role in telephone deregulation. (Attachment 1)

The information requested from the Department of Commerce and Housing regarding the Community Service Program Awardees and Contributors was distributed to the Committee. (Attachment 2)

Jerry Lammers, Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC), briefed the Committee on the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF). (Attachment 3)

Mr. Lammers stated initially the KCC opened the Competition Docket Phase I and identified there were subsidies built into the existing rate schedule, especially in access rates.. The Commission created the Universal Service Task Force, with members from all segments of the industry. The Telecommunications Strategic Planning Committee was established by the Legislature which determined that access charges were a significant source of a subsidy to ensure affordable rates to all Kansans. In February 1996, the Federal Telecommunications Act was passed by Congress which opened markets and jump-started competition. In addition, the Federal Act provided instructions to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to look at and establish a universal service fund. In 1996 the Kansas Telecommunication Act was enacted, and established the KUSF. In December, 1996 the KCC selected the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) to be the KUSF Administrator, at a cost of less than 1% of the KUSF. This organization also manages the FUSF.

Kansas was the first state to establish a universal service fund to support high cost for telephone service. There are presently 15 states which have established some sort of universal service fund and have some type of management of the fund. Mr. Lammers stated the Commission, the Legislature and the Companies who thought the legislation was appropriate all had a stake in the successful transition from the monopolistic pricing structure that existed before to one where universal service funding could be continued in a non-competitively neutral manner.

Mr. Lammers stated that in spite of an attempt to make the transition revenue neutral, there have been a number of complaints from constituents. The Commission has received over 1300 calls concerning the universal service fund.

Mr. Lammers stated he explained to constituents the universal service fund is not new. This type of support was recognized in the 1930's and was built into the long distance rates. In 1984 when AT&T was broken up the support was moved from being held by the long distance providers, since they were now going to be competitors, to the access rates charged by the local exchange companies. Due to the merging of technologies-- computers, cable TV, wireless, long distance and local telephone service--all wanting to get into 2-way telecommunications service, the reasoning was that it was not appropriate for only the local exchange

companies to be allowed to provide services. When the local exchange markets open to competition, the competition for long distance service increases dramatically. Companies may offer local and distance as well as other services. When this occurs, access charges will not apply, therefore, the support built into access rates is lost. If set above cost to recover lost support, access rates then constitute a barrier to competition for long distances providers who are not local service providers. The Commission was precluded by the Legislature from looking at costs, by requiring cost studies from the companies. In an attempt to achieve a revenue neutral transition, the Legislature reduced the access rates to the interstate rate level and provided that support will no longer be born by long distance users alone but will apply equitably to all telecommunication services including wireless. Mr. Lammers stated Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) has experienced a 19% reduction in its long distance rates and AT&T an 18% during the last year. The transition of the rate rebalancing to achieve true competition is over a three year period. We have completed only the first year.

Local exchange carrier revenues lost shall be recovered on a revenue neutral basis based on the volumes and revenues for the 12 months prior to September 30, 1996, adjusted for any rate changes. The legality of the "revenue Neutral" methodology rather than "cost" is before the court.

Over 95% of the KUSF goes to support the high cost of providing local service in high cost areas of rural Kansas; the remainder funds the hearing impaired program and the Lifeline program.

Mr. Lammers stated the KCC was required by the Kansas Telecommunications Act to take certain truisms into consideration when setting the amount of the KUSF. The KUSF was set at \$112 million per year, and of that amount \$106 million was to be used in high cost rural areas. In the first year \$77 million was collected. During the Phase II hearings there was discussion of shifting a lot of this to local service rates. The local exchange carriers, SWBT and Sprint were in favor of this shift; however, the independent carriers did not want the increase on their local customers. This option was not viable inasmuch as such a shift would increase the disparity between independent rates and SWBT and Sprint. The Act required the of a USF had to be done on an equitable and non-discriminatory basis.

The FCC, on August 8, 1997, came out with their order on how to do interconnection and how to price for unbundled loops. The order introduced a concept requiring unbundled loops be priced out in at least three different rates: metropolitan, cities and rural. This order necessitated SWBT's participation in the KUSF in order to establish competition and to contribute to the KUSF on an equitable and nondiscriminatory basis. The KCC, therefore, ordered that the support for all inequities be recovered as a KUSF assessment. A \$2.00 charge to SWBT customers was the result of this order, and a \$1.00 local shift for those below the average for rural companies. Rate rebalancing is to be implemented over a three year period and the first year access charges have been reduced by 55% for SWBT and Sprint, and rural companies reduced their access all the way down to the interstate rate. Increases for pay telephones, directory assistance calls and the \$2.00 per line assessment went to the KUSF and were allowed to be passed through to the customers.

Mr. Lammers informed the Committee that SWBT will receive a little less than three-fourths of the KUSF. The amount SWBT collects closely off-sets the amount they are entitled to.

The reserve amount in the KUSF as of November 1997 is \$13 million. This balance allows the KCC to decrease the assessment for next year.

Mr. Lammers stated there will be additional pressure to increase the size of the KUSF to assist in infrastructure plans; to fund intrastate access reductions to match decreasing interstate charges; and to recover reductions in Federal universal service funding.

Upon motion by Senator Barone, seconded by Senator Steffes, the Minutes of the January 23, 1998 meeting were unanimously approved.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.

The next meeting is scheduled for January 28, 1998.

High court to review phone deregulation

WASHINGTON (AP) — The fate of telephone deregulation into the next century shifted to the Supreme Court after it agreed Monday to decide whether the federal government or the states should play the dominant role.

Court officials said the dispute will not be handled until the court's 1998-99 term, which begins in the fall. No decision is expected until sometime in 1999. Until then, analysts don't expect any impact on phone customers or companies.

The cases at issue involve who will control opening the \$100 billion local telephone market to competitors — something sought as part of a 1996 telecommunications law.

They arise from a series of decisions by the 8th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals last year.

The most important decision, issued in July, said the Federal Communications Commission has no authority to tell local phone companies how much they can charge competitors to hook into local networks. Potential rivals need to do this to offer competing local phone service.

The court ruled that such pricing authority resides with individual states, not the FCC.

The FCC and long-distance companies AT&T and MCI want the Supreme Court to overturn the lower court's ruling and were pleased the high court decided to hear the case. They argue that a state-by-state patchwork of pricing policies discourages local phone competition and delays the day when telephone customers, particularly residential ones, have the same widespread choices for local phone service as they now do in long-distance.

A uniform, national pricing policy, they argue, makes it easier for local phone competitors to break into the business and ensures that local phone compe-

tion comes more quickly. In theory, such competition would lower local phone prices.

State regulators and local phone companies, including the regional Bells, want to preserve the lower court ruling. They argue that states are in the best position to adopt pricing rules because they know their local phone markets and their phone customers' needs.

"Different parts of the country have different realities in terms of costs to provide service and the federal government should respect the jurisdiction and judgment of the states," said Bell-South's associate general counsel, William Barfield.

"States know best," said James Ramsay, assistant general counsel of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners, adding: "Practically speaking, the average telephone ratepayer has much more of a voice with state public utility commissions than in Washington, D.C."

If the Supreme Court overturns the 8th circuit's ruling, it will delay when consumers have widespread local phone competition, local phone companies and states argue.

The court's ruling in July dealt a major setback to the FCC's efforts to create a national policy encouraging local phone competition. The FCC's rules, adopted in 1996, were suspended by the same court and never took effect. States have been moving forward with their own pricing rules, similar to the FCC's.

The high court's decision to review the case "gives local consumers hope, but not competition," said MCI's chief policy counsel, Jonathan Sallet.

The high court also will review 8th Circuit decisions involving how local phone companies make some services available to competitors.

"It will be a couple of years before anyone sees a light at the end of that tunnel," said Jeffrey Kagan of Kagan Telecom Associates, an Atlanta-based consulting firm.

KANSAS UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (KUSF)

Presented by Jerry Lammers, KCC Staff

January 27, 1998

A. History

- 1 KCC Competition Docket Phase 1 and Universal Service Task Force
- 2 Telecommunications Strategic Planning Committee
- 3 The Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996
- 4 The State Act of 1996
- 5 National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) is selected to be the KUSF Administrator

B. The wisdom of the State Act

- 1 What I tell consumers about access, toll and the KUSF (See Attachment 1)
- 2 Largest long distance reductions in Kansas history
- 3 Funding for universal service is taking advantage of the growth in industry revenues.

C. KCC Decision on KUSF

- 1 Shifting all to local service
 - a) Doing for S.W. Bell Telephone (SWBT) and Sprint only increased the gap for local rates between them and independent company customers.
 - b) "Equitable and nondiscriminatory" meant that local customers must pay KUSF as well as a local increase occurring at the same time.
 - c) FCC ordered pricing for unbundled loops to be done using at least 3 tiers.. Portability of support for Competitive Local Exchange Companies would be eliminated if SWBT did not participate in the KUSF.
 - d) KCC ordered that the support all be recovered as a KUSF assessment.

2 Implemented the \$1.00 local shift ordered for rural companies (Sec. 6 (d))

3 Implemented a three year transition for access charges with 55% of the reduction for SWBT and Sprint being done in the first year.

4 Assessment was made on retail telecommunications services.

E. Problems

- 1 Reduce the assessment percent. Complaints by cellular and others.
- 2 Solutions include:
 - Benefit by the growth in revenues
 - Shifting some to a local rate increase
 - Controlling increasing demands on the fund
- 3 LEC pass thru of the assessment and impact in competitive resale

F. Future and what is working

- 1 Next assessment level in 1998
- 2 Local, private line services, wireless, and long distance are being assessed the same
- 3 Wireless will be a replacement for wire line services

G. Future and pressures to increase the size of KUSF

- 2 Interstate Access is decreasing and means that Kansas will have to make further access reductions in the future
- 3 Reductions in Federal USF means that there will be pressure to increase intrastate rates or make recovery in the KUSF.

KANSAS UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (KUSF)

Explanation to Customers

Not New - Started in 1930's - Long distance should support high cost service areas

In 1984 - Divestiture - move the support in the access rates charged by the local exchange companies so recovery is still 100% in long distance rates.

Merging of technologies -Computers, cable TV, wireless, long distance and local telephone service. Everyone wants to be able to do 2 way communication.

Opening the local market to competition, accelerates the competition for long distance service. When companies provide local service, they will be vertically integrated offering local and long distance as well as other services. When this occurs, access charges will not apply, thus the support built into access rates is lost. In addition, access rates if they are set above cost in order to recover support, they constitute a barrier to competition for long distance providers who are not local service providers.

The Commission and the Legislature were concerned about this. The Legislature passed the Kansas Act to address the situation.

It reduced the access rates to the interstate rate level. One of the most frequent complaints we have heard in the past is that it is cheaper to call interstate than within Kansas. (Example)

The Kansas Act provides for long distance rates to be reduced. The Act provides that the support will no longer be born 100% by long distance users but will apply equitably to all telecommunications services including wireless.

The Subsidy

Over 95% of the subsidy goes to support the high cost of providing local service in high cost areas of rural Kansas. The remainder is going to fund the Kansas Relay Center for the hearing impaired, TAP, and the Lifeline program.
