Chairperson Corbin announced that he intended to offer an amendment on the floor to amend **HB 2499 - concerning controlled shooting areas** into HB 2868 the nonresident deer permits bill. He said the Committee had not had an opportunity to hear **HB 2499** because the committee received it so late.
