The minutes of the January 15 meeting were approved on a motion by Senator Harrington and seconded by Senator Feleciano. Carried.

The Chair recapped **SB 407** and **SB 408** and announced that each bill would be considered in separate subcommittees on Thursday, January 22. The Chair read two bill requests from the Kansas Sentencing Commission and two bill requests from the Kansas Bankers Association. All were received immediately prior to this meeting.

**SB 155 - Creating the crime of giving a check drawn against a closed account**

Conferee Grant expressed sincere apologies for the failure of Conferee Lockett to appear before the Committee as scheduled. He briefly summarized the history and purpose of the bill but stated that he had no testimony prepared. There were no other conferees testifying on **SB 155**.
