The minutes for the January 13th, 1999 meeting were presented for approval or corrections. Representative Grant made a motion to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Representative Myers and the motion carried.

Representative Loyd made a motion to introduce Governor Graves transportation plan, seconded by Representative Flower and the motion carried.

Representative McKinney made a motion to introduce a bill concerning the taxation of aviation fuel. This was seconded by Representative Larkin and the motion carried.

The Chair called on Representative Lane who requested introduction of a bill relating to motor vehicle insurance, concerning accident prevention courses. This bill would provide an appropriate reduction in premium charges from a two year period to a three year period after completion of a motor vehicle accident prevention course as approved by the National Safety Council or a governmental agency such as the State Board of Education. Representative Pauls made a motion to introduce this bill, seconded by Representative Ballou and the motion carried.

Representative Flora introduced his pages for the day, two of whom were from Our Lady of Guadalupe school and one from Seaman High School.

The Chair introduced Secretary of Transportation Dean Carlson.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:55 p.m.
