MINUTES OF THE SENATE EDUCATION.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson SENATOR BARBARA LAWRENCE at 9:00 a.m. on January 25, 1999 in Room 123-S of the Capitol.

Chairperson called the meeting to order and asked for bill introductions.

Mark Tallman, Kansas Association of School Boards, explained the first bill request which would broaden the current Kansas charter school law. He stated that it is virtually identical to legislation introduced by the committee last year.

The second piece of legislation requested by Mr. Tallman would make several amendments to the school safety and security act.

Mr. Tallman was asked a few brief questions and then the Chairperson asked for action on the bill requests.

**Senator Bleeker moved the introduction of the bill requests. Senator Kerr gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.**

The Chairperson asked for action on the minutes of January 14, January 19, January 20 and January 21. **Senator Emert moved approval of the minutes of January 14, 19, 20 and 21. Senator Langworthy gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.**

The committee turned to the agenda for the day. Senator Emert had a sheet distributed that defined the subject matter of **Senate bills 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36 and 37**, and explained the reason for the need to repeal.

A few brief comments were made regarding some of the bills on the list.

The Chairperson called for action on the bills.

**Senator Oleen moved the passage of Senate bills 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36 and 37. Senator Emert gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.**

The Chairperson urged committee members to be on time, as prompt attendance would be appreciated.
