

MINUTES OF THE SENATE FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE.

Chairman Harrington recognized Senator Robert Tyson who requested the introduction of a bill for a slight increase in sales tax in Ottawa.

Senator O'Connor moved to introduce the bill. Senator Brungardt seconded the motion. The motion carried.

SB 34 - Concerning audits of the Kansas Lottery

Chairman Harrington explained that Senator Vratil had proposed an amendment to the lottery bill to change the year 2002 to 2004 so that the dates would be consistent with the policy set forth in the bill to have a lottery audit at least every three years.

Theresa Kiernan explained that Post Audit wanted to be able to make sure that those whom are contracted to do the lottery audits would still be subject to a background check.

Senator O'Connor moved to accept the entire balloon amendment. Senator Brungardt seconded that motion. The motion carried.

Senator O'Connor moved to report the bill favorably to the entire senate. Senator Teichman seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Gooch abstained from voting.
